





MOSCOW ARRIVALS

Today Moscow is not only the political center of Russia but also the country's most populous city and its industrial, cultural, scientific, and educational capital. Moscow has one of the fastest growing economical centers in the world with an active business life with an enormous changing profile/ skyline. Investments in making the city looking more and more beautiful have been made. There are green areas, facade lightning, water fountains in the River. Kremlin, St. Basil's Cathedral, Red Square, Stalin's Skyscrapers – these are just a few sights which are world famous and which are definitely worth seeing!

MOSCOW INTRODUCTION SIGHTSEEING TOUR

Red Square is a city square in Moscow, Russia. It separates the Kremlin, the former royal citadel and now the official residence of the President of Russia, from a historic merchant quarter known as Kitai-gorod.

Sparrow Hills is a hill on the right bank of the Moskva River and one of the highest points in Moscow. On top of the hill, 85m above the river, is the observation platform which gives a beautiful panoramic view of the city. Standing on the observation platform you can see almost all of central Moscow:

- The Luzhniki Stadium (where the 1980 Olympic Games took place);
- The domes of Novodevichy convent;
- The Kremlin churches;
- Christ the Savior Cathedral;
- Seven Sisters, Stalin's high-rise buildings.





RED SQUARE WITH KREMLIN AND CATHEDRALS

Red Square, the heart and the soul of Moscow and the entire Russian people, history steeped spot that will impress you with its dazzling architecture. Wind your way past Alexander Garden and Iberian Gate and Chapel, snap a photo of the plaque at “point zero” and feast your eyes on quirky vibrant domes of St Basil’s Cathedral. See the small and charming Kazan Cathedral and large cream colored GUM department store and hear about prominent Soviet leader when you’ll take a short stop in front of Lenin’s Mausoleum.

- Discover the oldest square in Moscow and amazing cathedrals where Russian rulers used to get married, crowned, and buried
- See all the Kremlin's grounds and the largest Tsar-Bell and Tsar-Cannon in the world
- Explore 8 hundred years of Russian history in one place with a passionate local guide

OLD ARBAT WALKING STREET TOUR AND GIFT SHOPPING

Unique pedestrian street, between the Garden Ring and Boulevard Ring roads. Houses dated by the 19-th and the beginning of the 20-th centuries, in empire and modern styles. Old Arbat Street is Moscow’s walking zone, shopping mile, with many bookstores, florists, a pet shop, jewelry and clothing stores, art galleries, theaters, souvenir stores, cafes and restaurants. It is one of the oldest streets in Moscow.





SPARROW HILLS VISIT

Sparrow Hills (Vorobyovy Gory), named after the village Vorobyovo, is a famous Moscow park, located on one of the so called "Seven hills of Moscow". It's a green hill on the bank of the Moskva river, huge beautiful park, pedestrian embankment, river station, and observation platform, which gives the best panorama of the city, Moskva River, and a view of Moscow State University, it's close to. No words or even photos can describe just how gorgeous picture of Moscow is, which takes your breath away. You'll see it's really rich for the sights.



VICTORY PARK & GORKY PARK SIGHTSEEING

One of the main sights in the west of Moscow is Victory Park (Park Pobedy) which is located on what is known as Poklonnaya Gora (Submission Hill) as historically this was where guests coming to Moscow from the West were expected to bow down (poklonitsya) and pay homage. Today it is an important venue for Russia's Victory Day celebrations on 9 May where veterans gather and are thanked and given flowers by younger generations.

RADISSON BOAT MOSCOW RIVER CRUISE

See some of the major attractions of the metropolitan city center and immerse yourself in its incredible history. Cruise past the legendary walls of the Moscow Kremlin, built on the orders of the 15th-century Grand Prince Ivan III to contain some of the city's most famous attractions.

Pass the controversial statue of Peter the Great by Zurab Tseretelli, and hear the amazing story of the Cathedral of Christ the Savior. Discover a modern art space developed on the site of the former Red October chocolate factory and more.

- Cruise down the Moscow River on a snow-white yacht
- Enjoy breathtaking views from the upper deck
- Enjoy Vodka and Red Caviar tasting during the cruise / optional activity





MOSCOW METRO TOUR

Take our Moscow Metro Tour and discover why our subway is recognized as the most beautiful in the world! "They used to have palaces for kings, we are going to build palaces for the people!" said one of the main architects of the Soviet subway. With us you will see the most beautiful metro stations in Moscow built under Stalin: Komsomolskaya, Revolution square, Novoslobodskaya, Mayakovskaya.



IZMAILOVO KREMLIN AND MARKET VISIT

Discover Izmaylovo District and Izmailovo Kremlin, a historical part of Moscow that was once the ancestral land of the noble Romanov family.

Your guide will immerse you in the atmosphere of the past, to see masters of handicraft at work, such as blacksmiths, potters, and wood carvers. You can even take part in the process, producing artworks of the applied and decorative arts. The history of Izmaylovo dates back to 1389, but it wasn't until 1935 that it was incorporated into the city of Moscow. Among its highlights is the urban forest of Izmaylovsky Park, some 3.5 times larger than New York's Central Park.



VDNKH AREA INCLUDING FOUNTAINS AND OSTANKINO TV TOWER PHOTOSTOP

This magnificent park in the north of Moscow features more than 250 Soviet-era palaces and pavilions, arches and fountains, a Vostok rocket and Soviet aircraft. The Soviet name VDNKh is an acronym meaning "the Exhibition of the Achievements of the National Economy". The area of this complex is greater than that of the Principality of Monaco; it is like a fantastic town with its own avenues, squares and gardens.

CHECK OUT FROM HOTEL & TRANSFER TO THE AIRPORT/TRAIN STATION

Please remember to instruct the reception about wake-up calls. Make sure that you take your passports and immigration forms from the hotel reception. Ensure correct and coordinated breakfast, luggage pull and bell service. Also provide time for individual payment at the reception for extra room charge.

DEPARTURE FROM MOSCOW AIRPORT

Moscow's three international airports are Sheremetyevo (Шереметьево), Domodedovo (Домодедово) and Vnukovo (Внуково). The airport furthest away is Domodedovo and the closest is Vnukovo. All three airports are connected with the city centre by Aeroexpress trains and also public buses, minibuses and taxis.

Domodedovo is the base for Russia's S7 airline, part of the Oneworld alliance along with British Airways, Iberia, Qantas and Germany's Lufthansa.

Vnukovo is the smallest airport among Moscow's Big Three and the base for Russia's low-cost airline Pobeda. It is also the arrival and departure point for the Russian airlines Utair and Gazpromavia, Turkish Airlines and a number of small airlines and low-cost carriers.
